Since 1978, the Dominican School of Philosophy and Theology has made its home in rented space in Berkeley's Graduate Theological Union (GTU). We have been well served in this location, and have experienced the blessings of growth as a place of learning and as a community of believers.



But the measure of our days here is drawing to an end. Our landlord, another GTU member school, needs our space for its own expansion. Soon, our campus home on Ridge Road will no longer be available for our use.

Yet in all of this, there is good news. God does not close a door without opening another. And for us, He has opened the door to the greatest of opportunities...a campus of our very own.



See it in your heart. A magnificent new center of learning and spiritual guidance. A special place of serenity, reflection, and understanding. A place to which the best and brightest are called as they prepare for the priesthood and for service in the laity.



Our School's permanent campus is sited on nearly an acre of land at the corner of Vine and Arch Streets – within walking distance of the Graduate Theological Union, the GTU library, and student housing. A spacious 15,000 square feet of academic, religious, and administrative facilities meets our present needs and will readily accommodate anticipated growth in our student population.

In the central courtyard, with its lawns and fountain, students, faculty, and staff alike find an informal space in which to meet and share fellowship, encouragement, and ideas and insights.

High-speed internet connections in our media lab link researchers with a universe of knowledge and with libraries around the world.

Transforming bricks and mortar into a place where we may empower, enlighten, and guide students in the



pursuit of academic excellence, ministerial growth, and commitment to service is not an easy task, nor is it inexpensive.

The purchase of the site and renovation of existing buildings requires an investment of \$3,000,000. This is a modest sum when compared with the costs of a “build from the ground up” project. 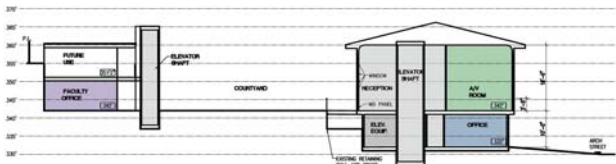
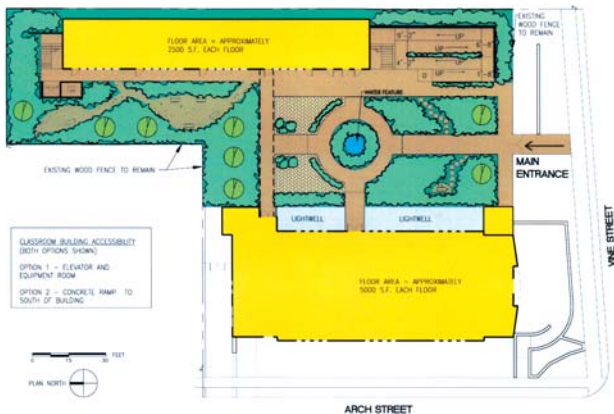

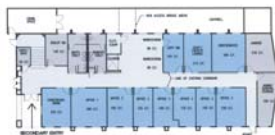
